The National Round Table on Sustainable Infrastructure (NRTSI)

- To be an independent, multi-stakeholder, non-partisan, not-for-profit advisory body that:
 - Provides decision-makers and stakeholders with advice on sustainable infrastructure;
 - Develops, commissions, collects, analyzes and shares data, trends, forecasts, technical and management innovation and tools;
 - Provides high level coordination of Infrastructure initiatives;



State-of-the-infrastructure reports

- Internationally:
 - Report Cards (USA, UK, AU)
 - Reports on the support of infrastructure to economic development (NZ)
- In Canada:
 - Infrastructure Needs studies (FCM, CUTA).
 - SotI reports by cities (e.g., Hamilton, Edmonton)

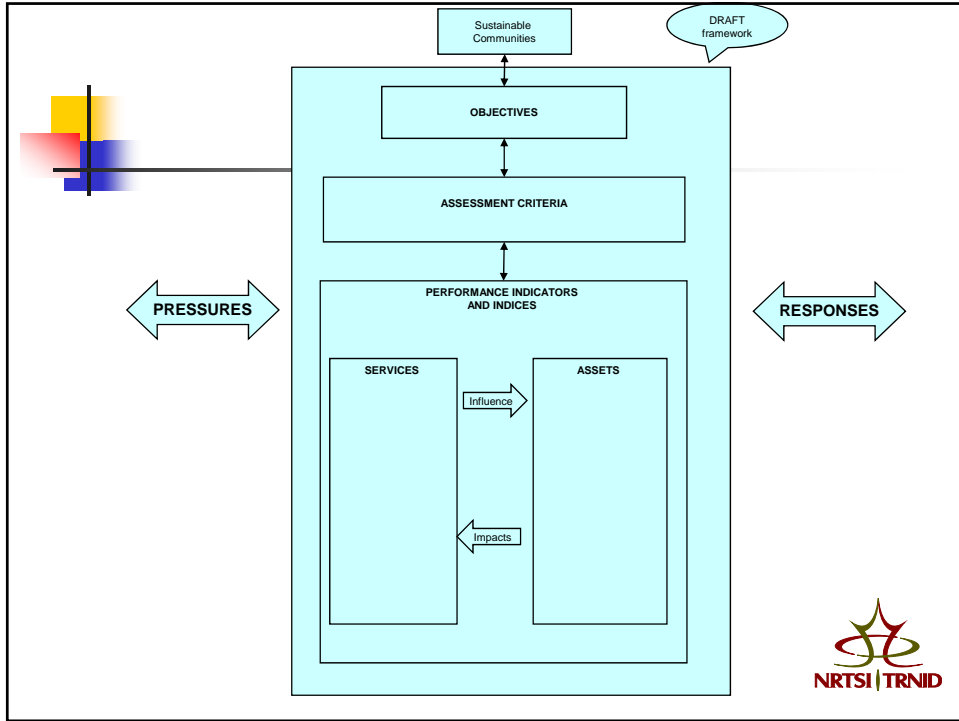

NRTSI -NRC Project

- Assessment of the State, Performance and Management of Canada's Core Public Infrastructure
 - Infrastructure = transport (roads, bridges, public transit) + health/Environment (potable water, wastewater)
 - Objectives: develop a framework of indicators that can be used by policy and decision makers, managers and operators of infrastructure
